FINANCES OF ALUMNI FIELD.

Treasurer Robert Thorne's Letter to Alumni—1071 Men Subscribe \$41,888—\$19,240 Collected—\$75,-000 Needed to Build Field.

Alumni in every part of the country have within the last few weeks received from Mr. Robert J. Thorne, '97, Treasurer of the New Athletic Field, a letter of which the following is a copy :

DEAR SIR :

DO YOU KNOW?

1. That Percy Field is flooded each Spring?

2. That Percy Field is too far away for both Athletes and gate receipts?

3. That Percy Field is not large enough for two sports at the same time?

4. That space is needed in the Fall for football players, 100; baseball, 50; lacrosse, 40; track team, 100; and 8 or 10 scrub games, inter-class games, handball, outdoor gymnasium, tennis courts and so forth? Room for 800 students at the same time!

5. That Percy Field is in bad condition from usage even when not flooded?

6. That there is no playground for inter-class games, or even for a game of "One-Old-Cat?"

7. That there is no way to discover latent Athletic ability in any student too modest to try for a Varsity team?

8. That there is no common meeting place for students except in down town resorts?

9. That the Athletic facilities of Cornell are surpassed by all the Universities and many Preparatory Schools?

10. That the Alumni Field is endorsed by Mr. Percy Hagerman, the Trustees, Athletes, Alumni and all friends familiar with the scheme?

11. That the Field is one block from the street cars, is located upon the Campus, and is only 10 minutes walk from 80 per cent. of the students' homes?

12. That this new Field will raise the standard of our athletics 20 per cent.

13. That \$40,000 of the \$75,000 is subscribed?

14. That the \$40,000 at present subscribed is chiefly in subscriptions of from \$10.00 to \$100.00 payable in cash or in 3 annual installments?

15. That you are earnestly requested to respond immediately with a subscription similar to the above?

16. That the entire proposition is so near success that Cornell cannot afford to have it fail now for lack of a few thousand dollars?

The Alumni Field Committee, soon after their appointment in 1901 divided the Alumni into geographical districts and each member of the Committee had absolute charge of the work of soliciting and collecting subscriptions for the district assigned to him as follows :

Geo. W. Bacon, '92, Chairman, New York City and Brooklyn.

Clyde P. Johnson, '93, all foreign countries, Ohio and New England.

Thos. McNeil, III, Pennsylvania and Southern New York.

Clinton R. Wyckoff, '96, New York State.

Robert J. Thorne, '97, All Western and Southern States and Territories.

The preliminary subscriptions of 1901,

1902 and 1903 were secured in this manner but it was found that this subdividing meant considerable crossing on account of the fact that the Alumni moved from one State to another with great frequency; also the expense was considerable. For these reasons the entire work of soliciting and collecting for the Alumni Field was this spring, placed in charge of Robert J. Thorne, '97, 120 Michigan Ave., Chicago, Treasurer of the Alumni Committee.

The list of names have all been consolidated and the work is being carried on at a very small expense. Mr. Thorne reports that his mail is constantly filled with enthusiastic letters in regard to the Field.

In the Club House when built it is intended to inscribe the names of all Cornellians by whose generosity the field was built. In a future issue we will show in detail the amount each class has subscribed towards the field.

Site of New College of Agriculture.

The site of the new College of Agriculture, as recommended by the state architect G. L. Heinz, and accepted by the Board of Trustees at its meeting on July 29th, is the high tract of land bounded by the new Garden avenue on the east.

This is the highest part of the Campus, being 870 feet above the sea level, and fifty feet higher than the ground about the Veterinary College, which is 820 feet above sea level.

Putting the college on this high ground will make it a prominent feature of the Campus, and as the buildings will also be of a design consistent with their position it will make it one of the most distinctive groups of building about the University.

Garden avenue is the new avenue that will shortly be cut through east of the Veterinary College, parallel to East avenue. It is to be 100 feet wide and will pass on the western side of the new athletic field.

Visitors who come to Cornell to see athletic contests in the future will perhaps see little of the University Campus except these new structures as they drive up Garden avenue but it is certain that their impressions of Cornell thus gained will be very favorable.

It is estimated that the plans for the different buildings which will constitute this new College of Agriculture will be completed in about two or three months.

The out of town members of the Board who attended the meeting on the 29th were J. D. Warner, J. C. Hendrix, and Miss Putnam of New York City, and Judge Turner, of Auburn.

TWO PROFESSORS APPOINTED.

William Lincoln Drew Succeeds Professor Cuthbert W. Pound—Maurice Prevot of Ecole des Beaux Arts Succeeds Professor Van Pelt.

William Lincoln Drew, Professor of Law in the University of Illinois, has been appointed to succeed Professor Cuthbert W. Pound as Professor of Law at Cornell and Maurice Prevot has been selected to fill the place made vacant by the resignation of Professor Van Pelt of the College of Architecture. The appointments were made on August 9th at a meeting of the Executive Committee of the Board of Trustees.

Professor Drew comes to Cornell from the Law School of the University of Illinois where he has been teaching for the past five years. He has also been secretary and resident administrative officer of that Law School. All familiar with him and his work commend unreservedly his ability and success as a teacher and his admirable qualities as a man.

Professor Drew was born at Newton, Ia., November 1, 1864. He graduated from the State University of Iowa in 1889 and took his law degree at the law school of the same university in 1892. He continued his law studies at the Harvard Law School during the year 1892-93 and was one of the editors of the Harvard Law Review. In 1893, he began the practice of law at Omaha, Nebraska, and continued in practice there until called to an assistant professorship of law at the University of Wisconsin in 1896. He remained for two years at Wisconsin and since 1898, has been a professor of law at the University of Illinois. He will teach at Cornell during his first year the subjects of criminal law, suretyship, partnership and corporations.

PROFESSOR PREVOT.

In selecting Mr. Prevot, President Schurman, who had the invaluable aid of Professor Trowbridge in Paris, was influenced by the desire to secure a man who had been thoroughly trained in the Ecole des Beaux Arts, where Professor Van Pelt had also received his architectural training.

Mr. Prevot is a graduate of the Beaux Arts of four years standing and has since been studying for the Grand Prix de Rome, which is the highest honor in art and architecture open to a student in France.

During his course in the Beaux Arts he won first prize in the Concours Chenavard, which is the most valuable prize offered by the school, a photograph of his composition, which is now in the collection of the College of Architecture, being considered one of remarkable excellence. He also received several medals on projects in design and won the Chaudesaigues, which is a very high honor in the school, besides winning honorable mention in Salon. There were ten candidates for the Grand Prix de Rome and of these Professor Trowbridge picked the two best, Mr. Prevot being one of the two.

Both these candidates were of exceptional ability and it was understood that the one who failed to secure the Grand Prix should receive the appointment to Cornell. Professor Trowbridge speaks of Mr. Prevot in the highest terms and says that there is no one superior to him in what is called the 24 hours Concours.

Memorial Tablets in Sage Chapel.

The University has recently put up marble tablets in Sage Chapel in memory of Professors Robert H. Thurston and Estevan A. Fuertes. They are placed on the west wall of the main part of the chapel to the left of the main south entrance.

The marble part of the tablets that bear the inscriptions is surrounded by a border of mosaics, and the lettering on the tablets is done in black.

The one nearest the south wall is that of the late Professor Thurston, and bears the following inscription :

"In Memory of
ROBERT HENRY THURSTON
October 25—1839.
October 25—1903.
Scholar—Author—Engineer—
Naval Officer.

From 1885—1903
DIRECTOR OF SIBLEY COLLEGE
AND PROFESSOR OF
MECHANICAL ENGINEERING.

Here he crowned by his success
as administrator and teacher,
a career devoted to the
advancement of science and
technical education."

The other tablet is a few feet farther north along the same wall, and at the corner of the west wing of the chapel. The following is the inscription which it bears :

"In Memory of
ESTEVAN ANTONIO FUERTES
PROFESSOR OF CIVIL ENGINEERING
from 1875
AND DIRECTOR OF THE COLLEGE OF
CIVIL ENGINEERING
from 1890 to 1902.

In him were blended authority,
urbanity and a love of justice.
He was expert in Letters and
Science, beloved of his pupils
and esteemed by his colleagues.

Born May 10, 1838.
Died January 16, 1903."

Attendance at Summer Session Broke all Records—153 Porto Rican Teachers Registered.

The Summer Session which closed on Thursday, August 18, was unusually successful both in attendance and the variety of courses offered for selection. As is customary, the registration consisted largely of those who are engaged or expect to be engaged in pedagogical work.

The number of students who took work during the summer was 571 exclusive of the 153 Porto Rican teachers. This is an increase of 100 over last year and of about 30 over the largest previous total, that in 1902. The visit of the Porto Rican teachers was one of the most interesting features of the session. The trip was not only a benefit to the Islanders but to many attending the session who took advantage of the presence of those thoroughly familiar with the Spanish language and clubs were formed for the mutual benefit of all.

Another delightful feature of the session was the work of the geography, geology and nature study departments. In these classes the work was largely out of doors. Never before in the history of the University have geological and

nature study excursions been conducted on such a large scale.

Under Professors Brigham, Tarr, Carnney, Hubbard and Emerson excursions were made to Taughannock Falls, Union Springs, Buffalo, Watkins Glen, Lake Ontario, and to the coal region around Wilkesbarre. The nature study work under Professor Colter has been popular and valuable.

Other departments drew to the Summer school many well-known educators all of whom expressed themselves as well pleased with the conduct of the work. Another pleasing feature of this year's session was the bi-weekly musical recitals in Barnes Hall and Sage Chapel. Miss Gertrude H. Nye, Mrs. Cora Gennung-Chamot, Clarence De Vaux-Royer and other well known local singers contributed to the pleasure of the entertainments.

Dr. Andrew Dickson White delivered an address toward the close of the session which attracted wide attention throughout the country, especially his reference to the critical situation in Russia and the death of von Plehve. Barnes Hall was totally inadequate to accommodate the immense crowd which gathered to hear the former president.

In order to accommodate the Porto Rican teachers who attended the session Dean DeGarmo arranged two special courses in which interpreters were used. These were exclusively for Porto Ricans in order to acquaint them with American elementary teaching methods. These sessions met each morning in Boardman Hall where instruction was given under the direction of Professor Burks of the Paterson, N. J., Normal School. The visitors were permitted to enter any other sections but they were not permitted the use of an interpreter.

At Harvard the system was arranged entirely different from that at Cornell University. There, the 350 Porto Rican teachers were divided into three groups according to their knowledge of the English language. In the two lower classes interpreters were used almost entirely.

In Cornell, however, only in the two method-study sections mentioned above was an interpreter required and as a result it was the opinion of the general manager of the expedition that those teachers who had been attending Cornell became more thoroughly conversant with the language than those instructed at Harvard.

expected. There has been a dearth of labor in Ithaca during the summer and this, added to the difficulty of securing stone, has greatly retarded the work. At best not more than one story of each building will be completed before winter.

Graham C. Patterson Elected Secretary of the Christian Association.

Ralph S. Kent, 1902, for the past year Secretary of the Christian Association has resigned that position and the trustees of the Association have elected Graham C. Patterson, 1904, as his successor. During the fall Mr. Kent will devote his entire time to his work in the Law School and to the coaching of the Freshman football team.


Mr. Patterson, who entered Cornell from Pittsburg in the fall of 1900, has been prominent in undergraduate affairs during his college course. He is a member of Delta Upsilon fraternity and of Sphinx Head; was President of the Christian Association, manager of the 1904 Cornellian and a member of the Second 'Varsity baseball team.

Mr. Kent's regime in Barnes Hall was an exceedingly prosperous one. The membership of the association was increased to more than six hundred and the Hall assumed a position in undergraduate life which it never before occupied. It carried on its religious work as vigorously as ever, and at the same time became a popular rendezvous for a host of undergraduates interested in a diversity of things.

Albert R. Coffin, 1904.

Albert R. Coffin who was stricken with malaria fever while in training with the Varsity crew at Poughkeepsie in June was removed to his home in Indianapolis on the day following the races and for six weeks thereafter was confined to his bed with typhoid fever. In the middle of August when he was again up and about it was not the Coffin of 172 but a man of 135.

Few men who have been graduated from Cornell have left a more honorable undergraduate record behind them than has Coffin, say the citizens of Cornell who have known him in his four years in Ithaca. He was a good man, a good student and a good athlete. For four years he played right half-back

on the football team and the paragraphs he wrote in football lore at Franklin Field and at Princeton Field, sometimes in the face of certain defeat, are the kind Cornell men are proud to talk about. He stroked his freshman crew at Poughkeepsie in June, 1901, and in his Sophomore year stroked the 1902 Varsity crew, perhaps the smoothest rowing machine Cornell has produced. In Junior year he was pace-maker for the crew that won the Poughkeepsie regatta by sixteen lengths and though he was rowing No. 2 in the Varsity boat at the time he fell ill in June it was generally known that he would resume his old position before the day of the big race. Coach Courtney pronounces him one of the two greatest strokes Cornell has ever had. And with all his successes and popularity in college he was as unassuming and modest a man as one could find in a good many days' journey.
