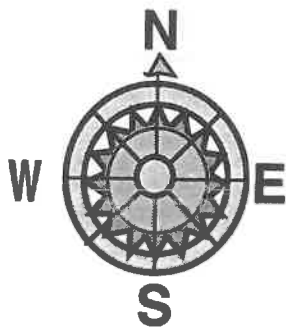
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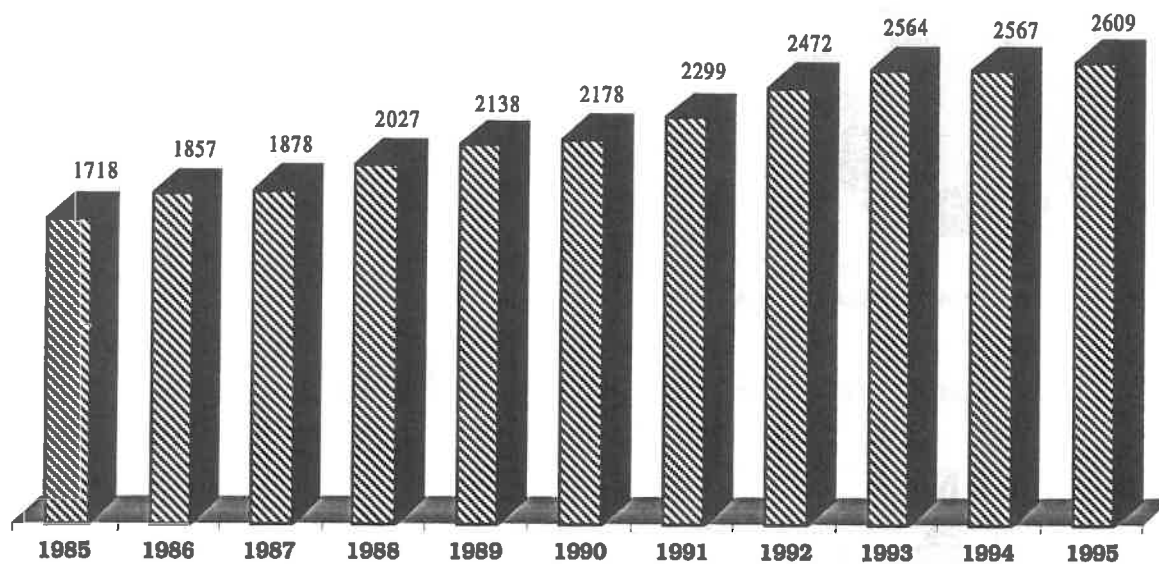

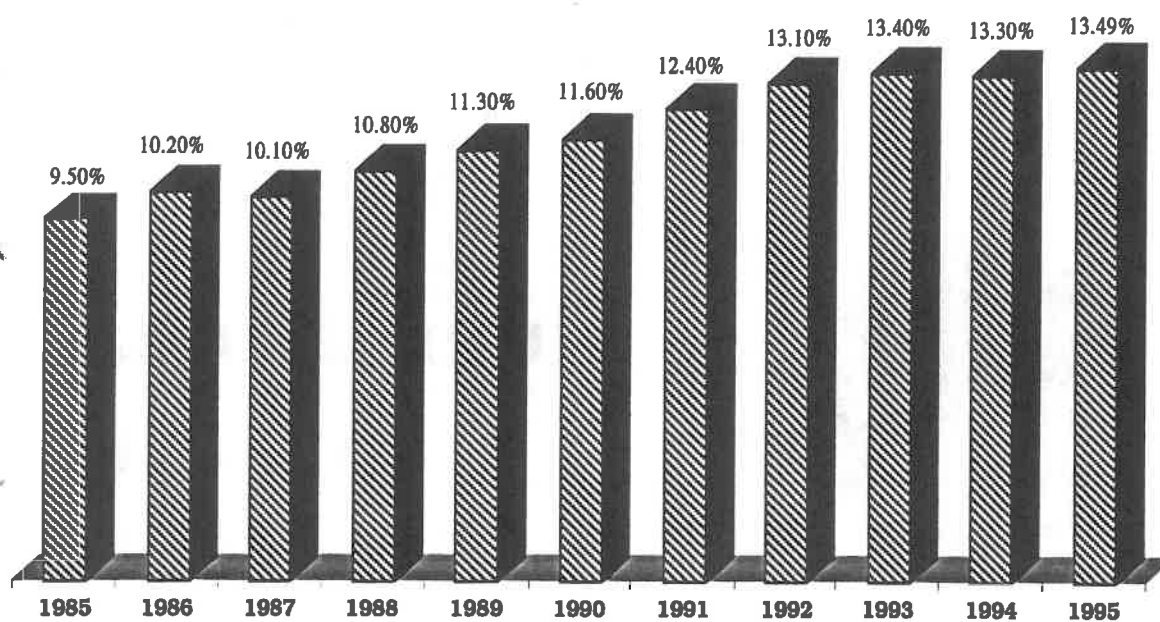


International Student Enrollment

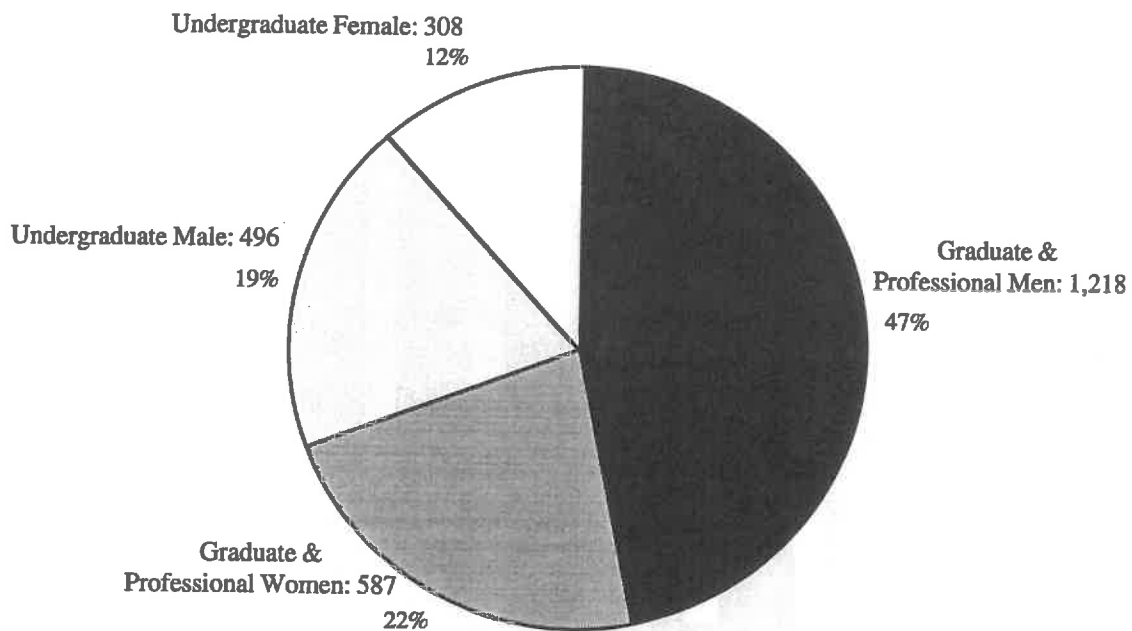

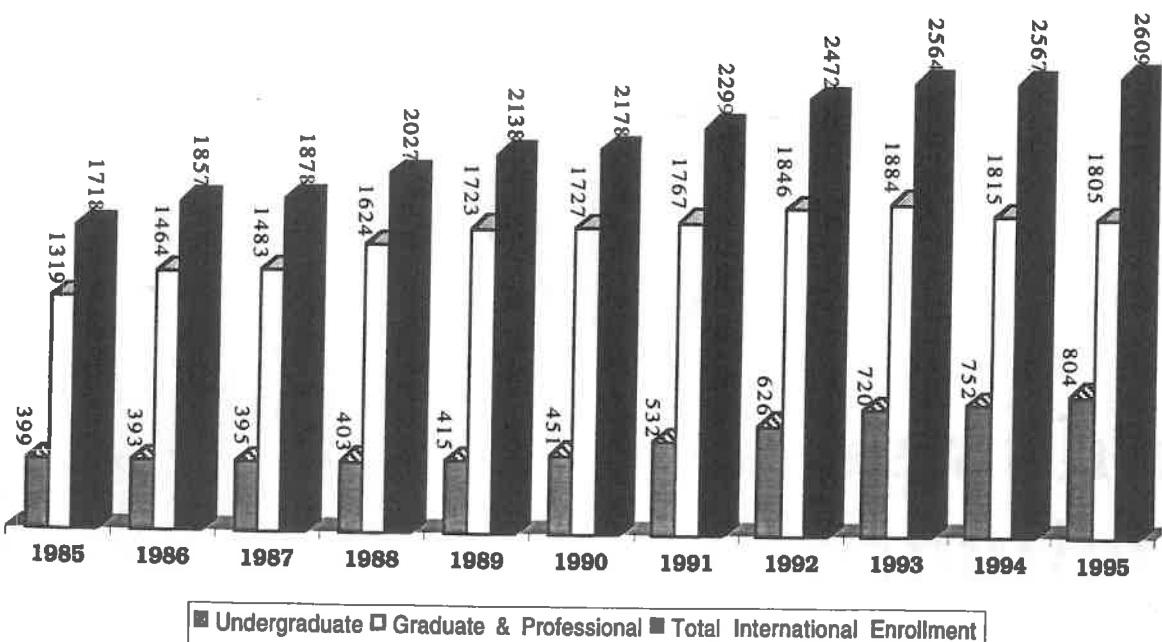

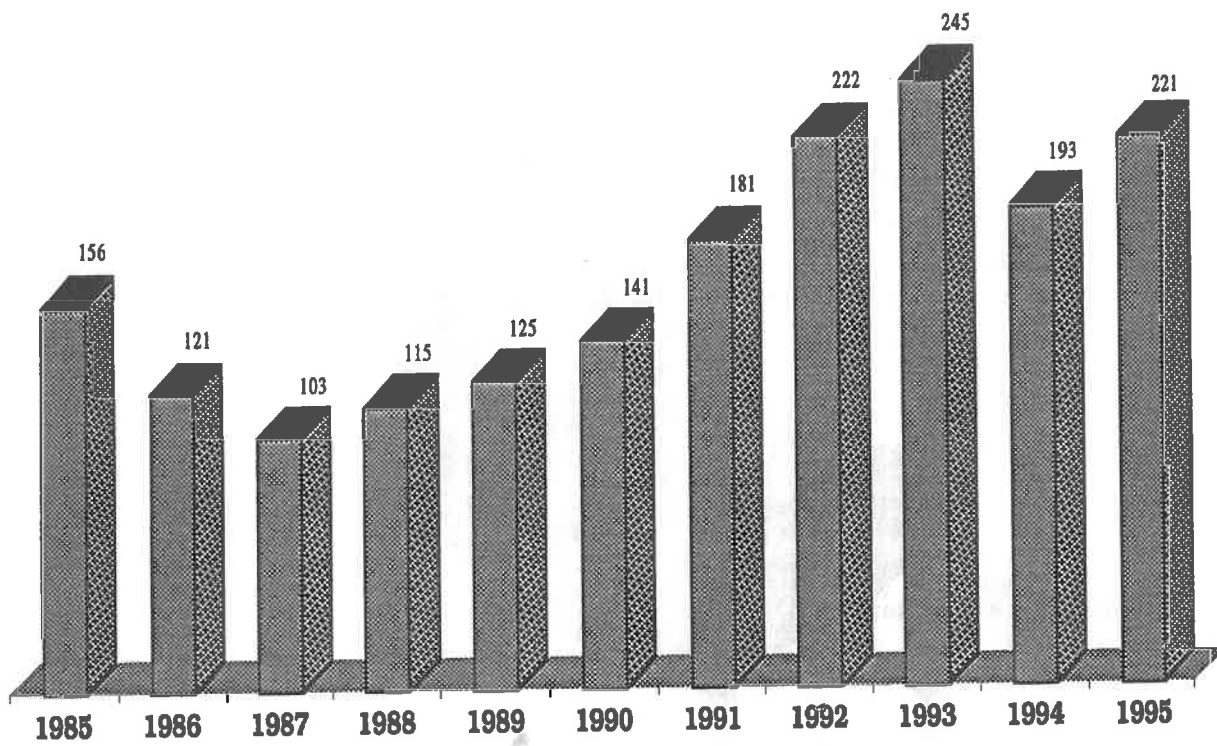
Graduate and Professional vs. Undergraduate International Students 1995-96



Graduate and Professional vs. Undergraduate International Enrollment 1985-1995

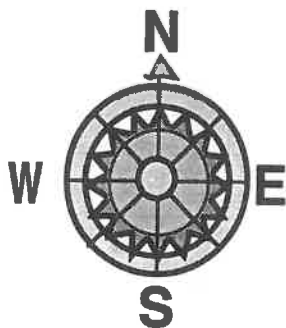

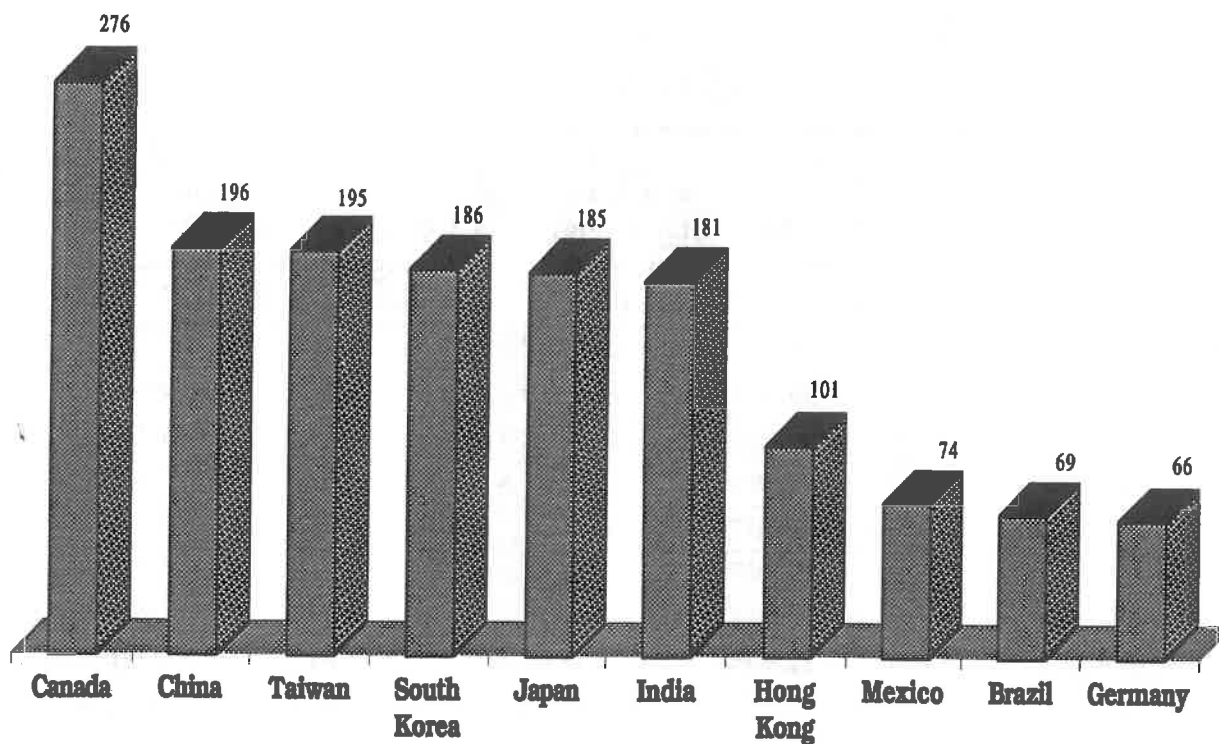

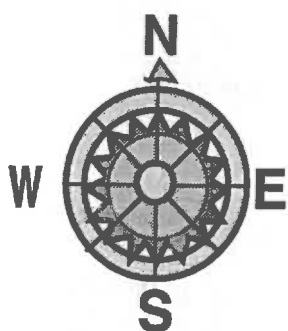

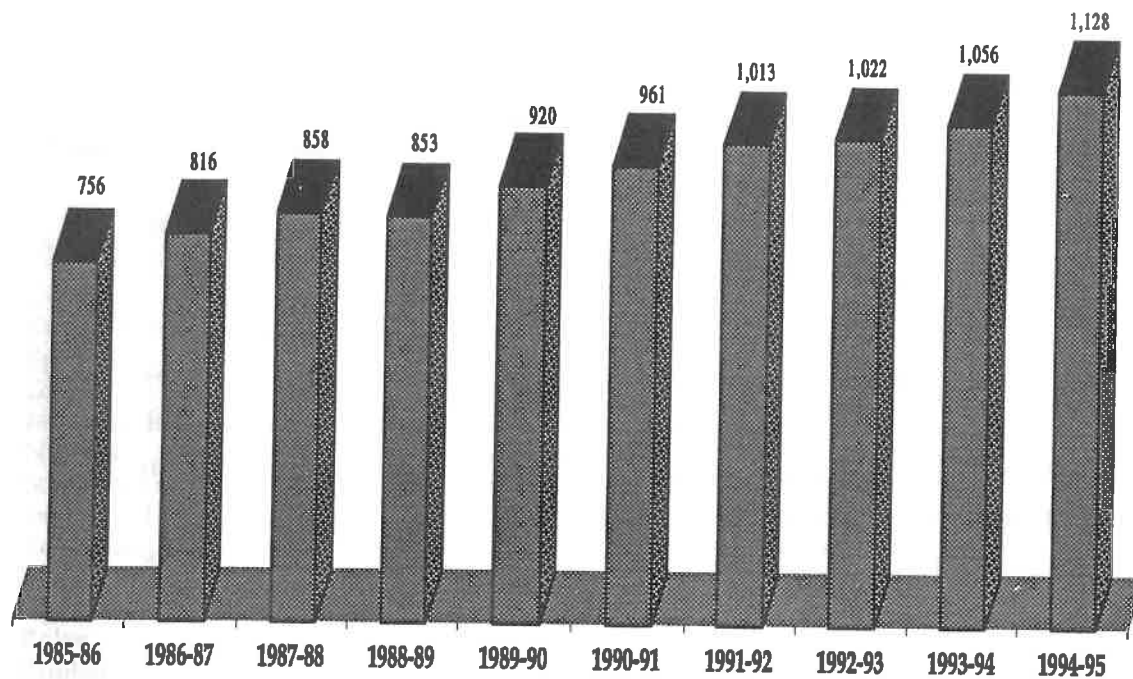

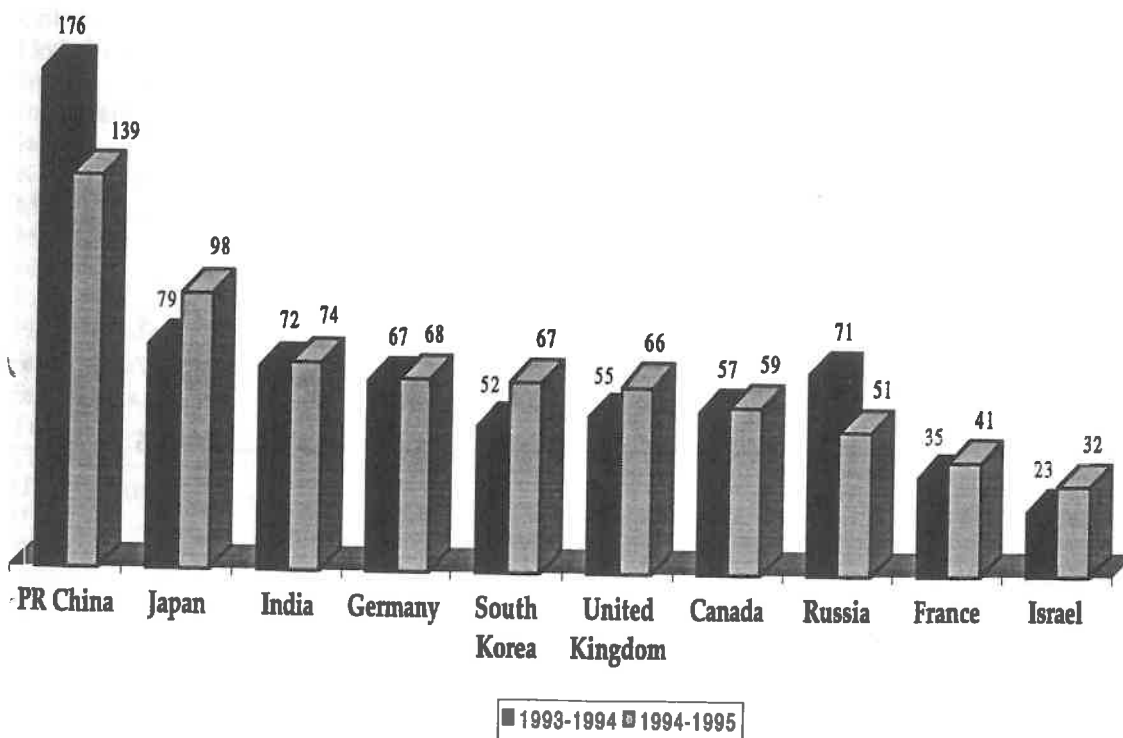

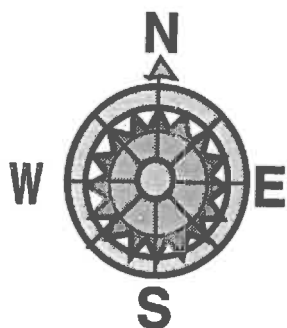

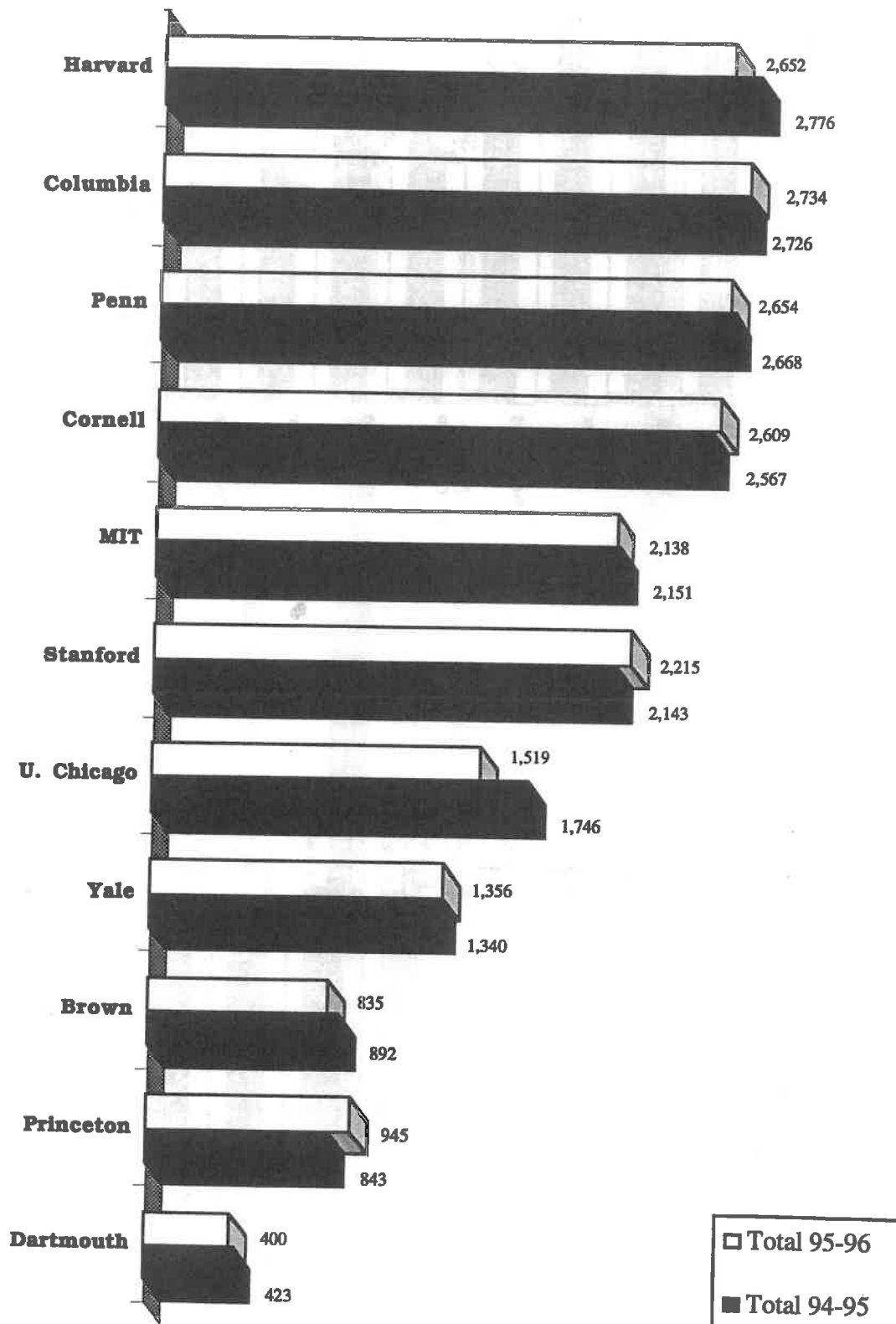

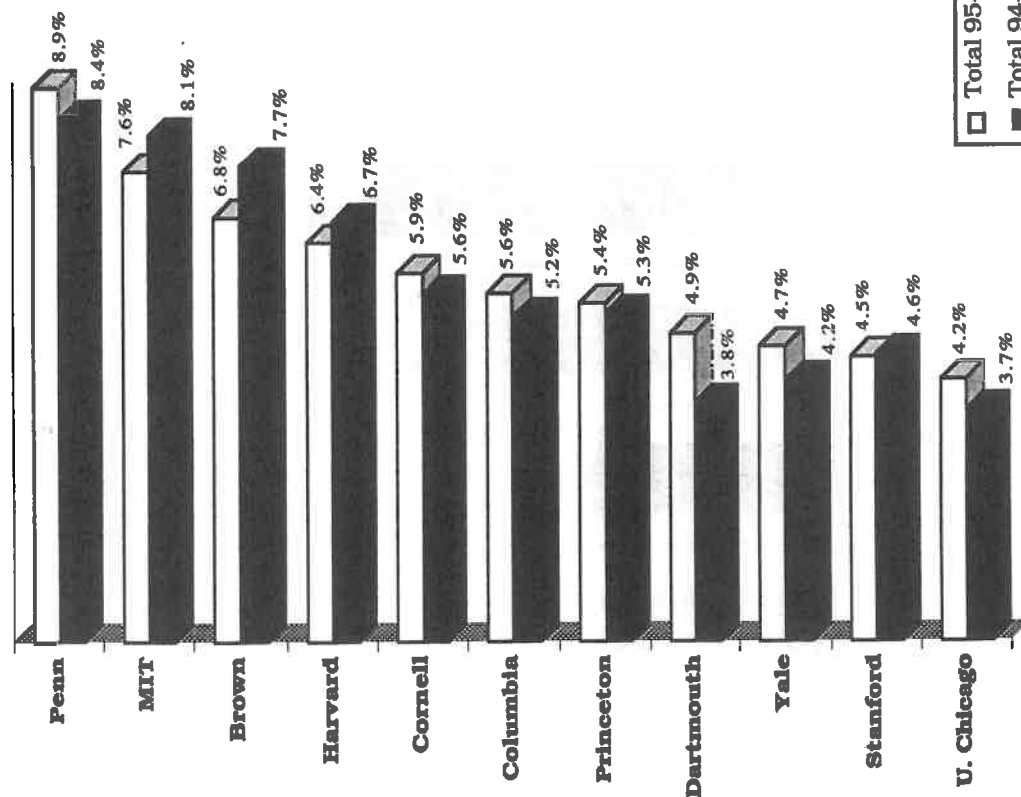

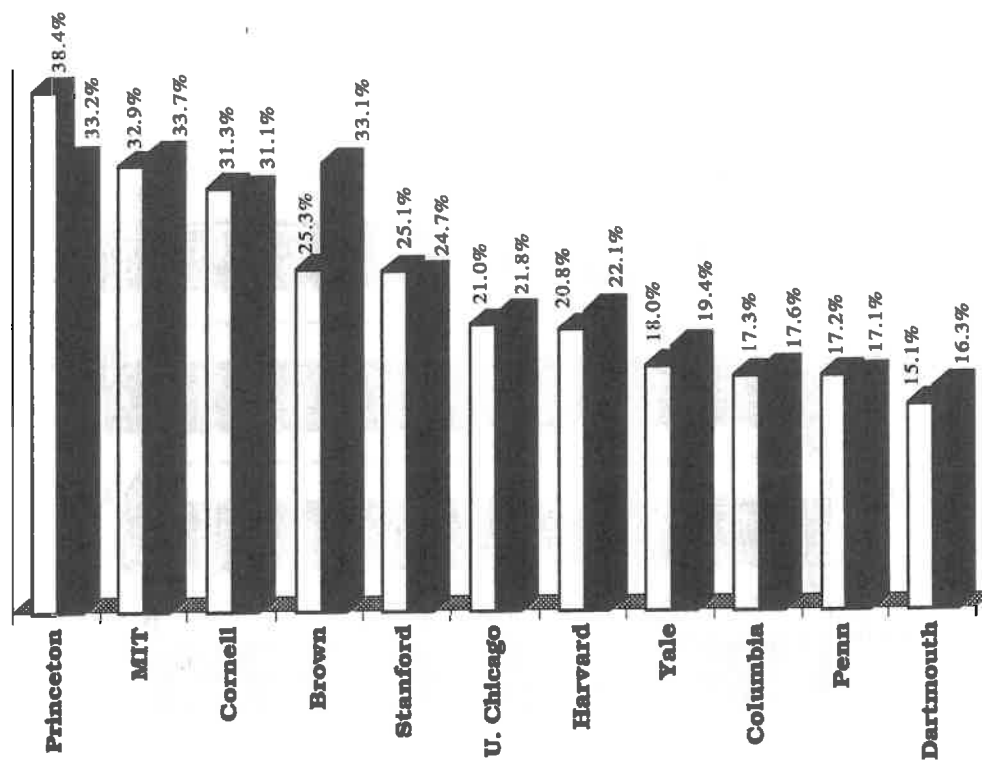
International Student Enrollment 1994-96 at Ivy League and Other Institutions

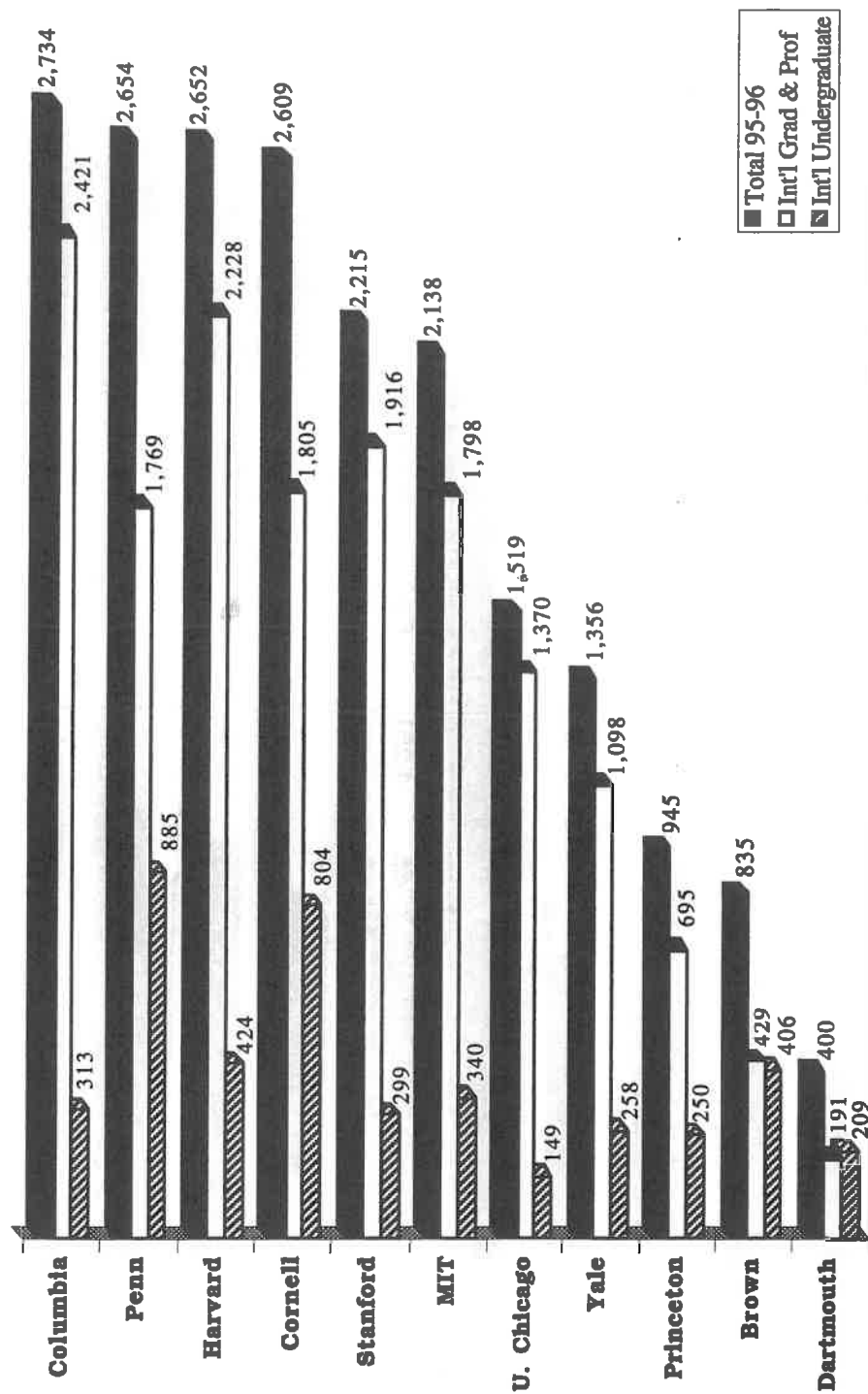

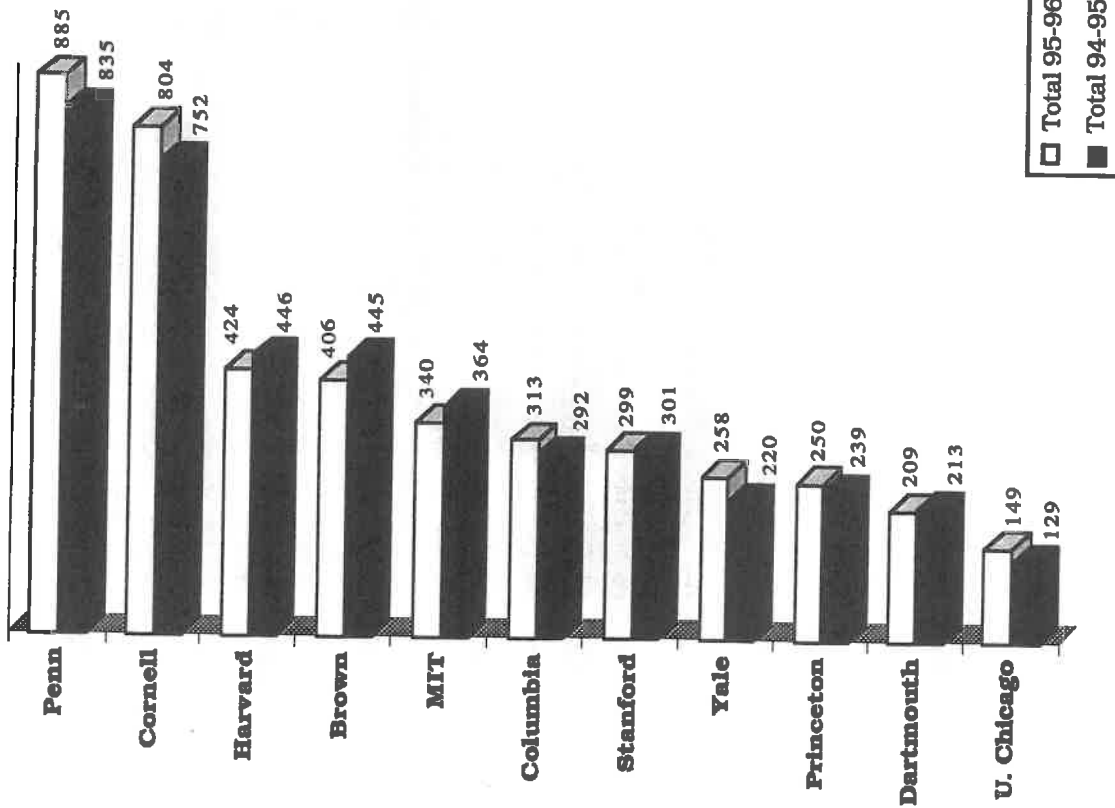

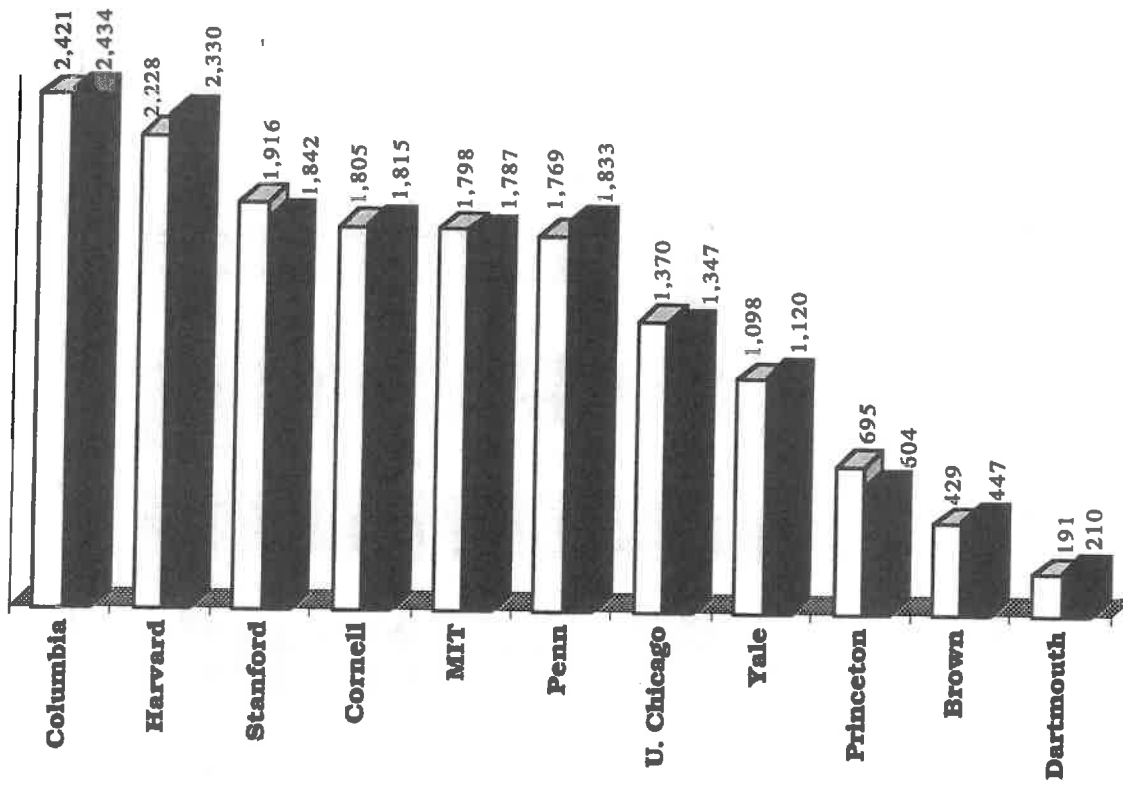
International Student Enrollment 1995-96 at Ivy League and Other Institutions
