### Where?

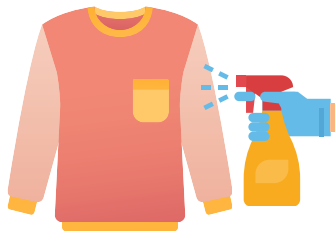
- Shady forested swamps



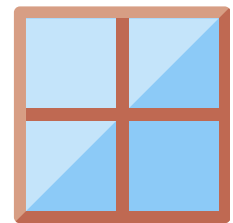
## Avoid EEE Virus by Preventing Mosquito Bites



Use bug spray



Use the insecticide permethrin on clothing



Cover up holes in your windows and doors



Wear long-sleeved clothing and socks



Get rid of water in buckets or open containers lying around outside
