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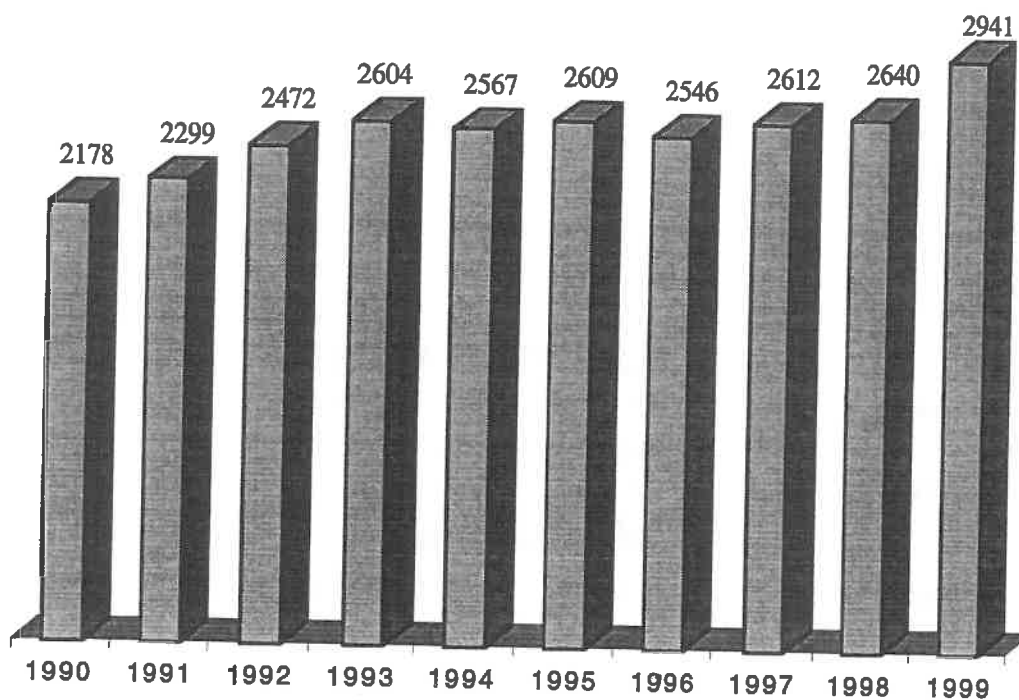

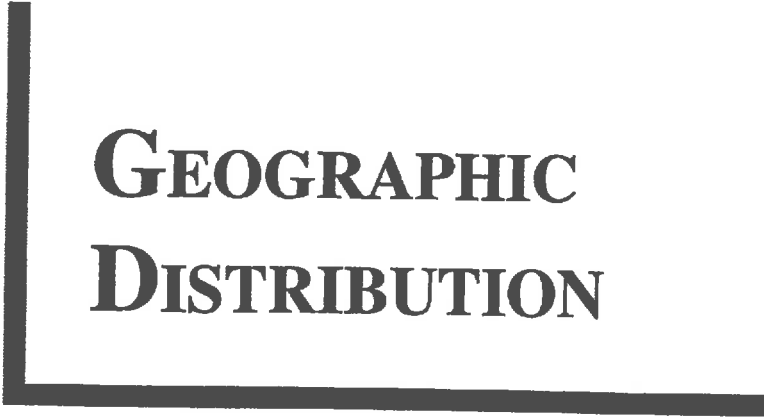

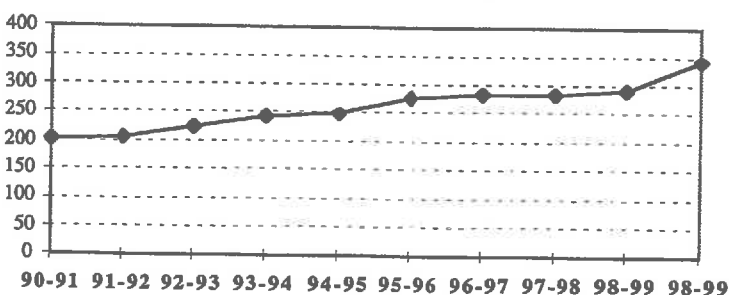

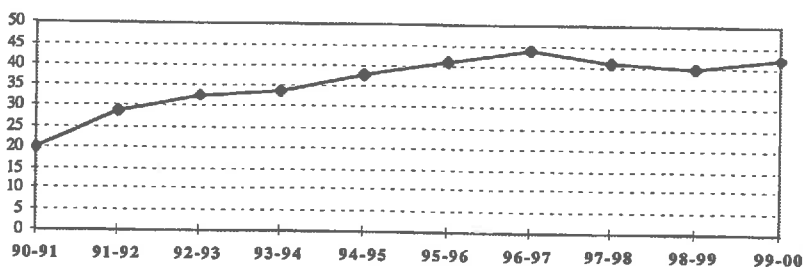

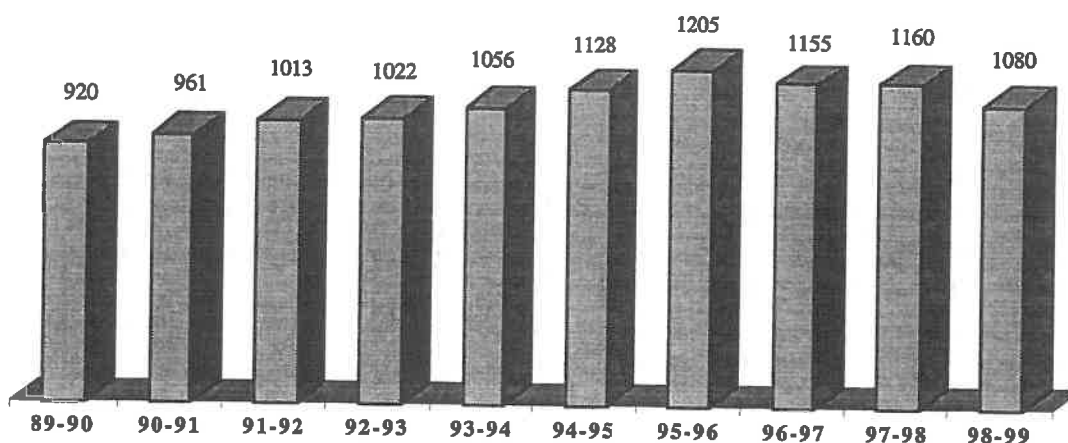

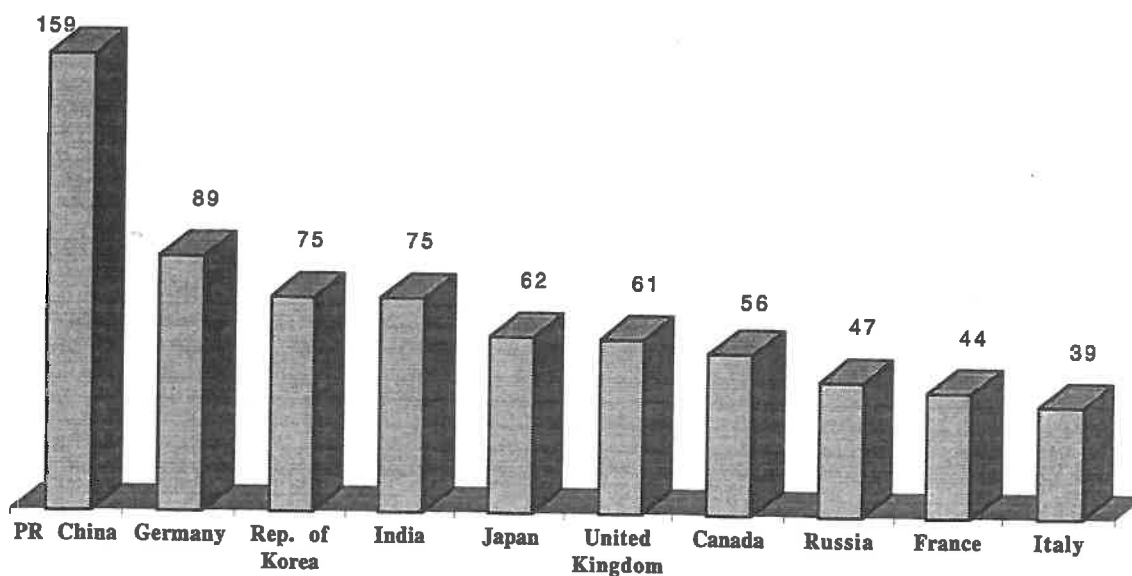

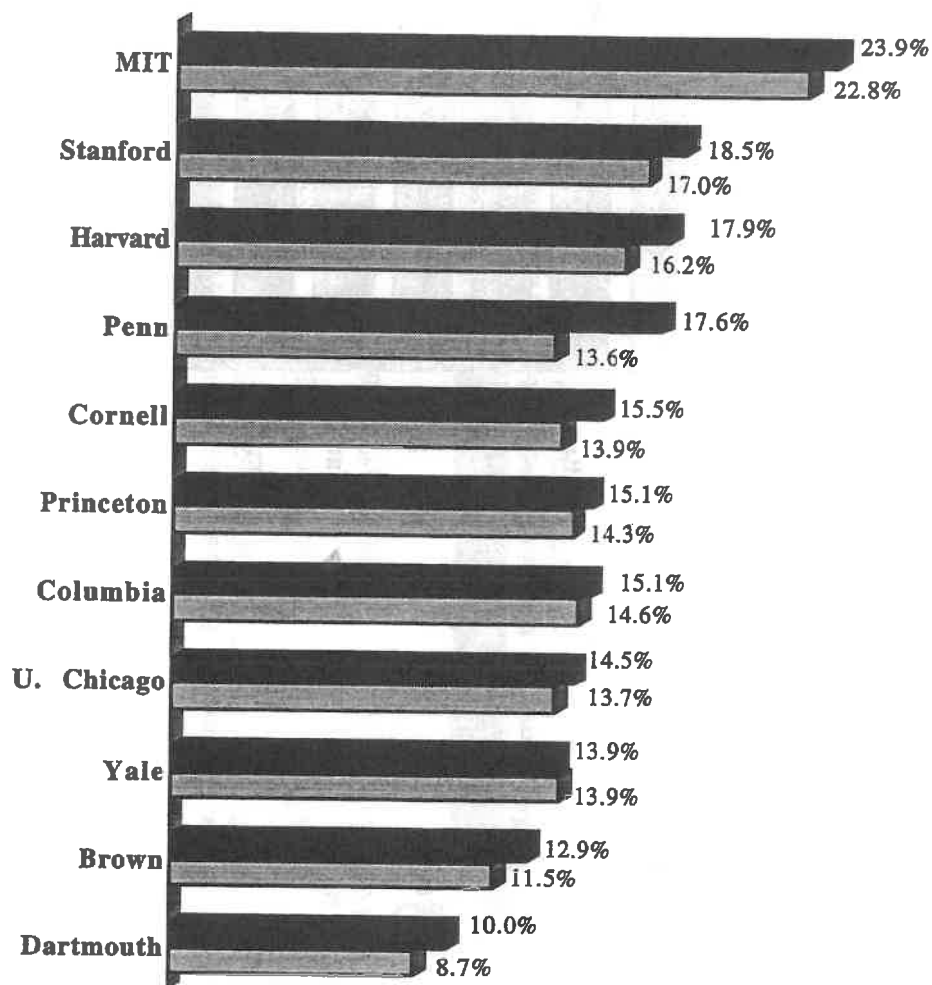

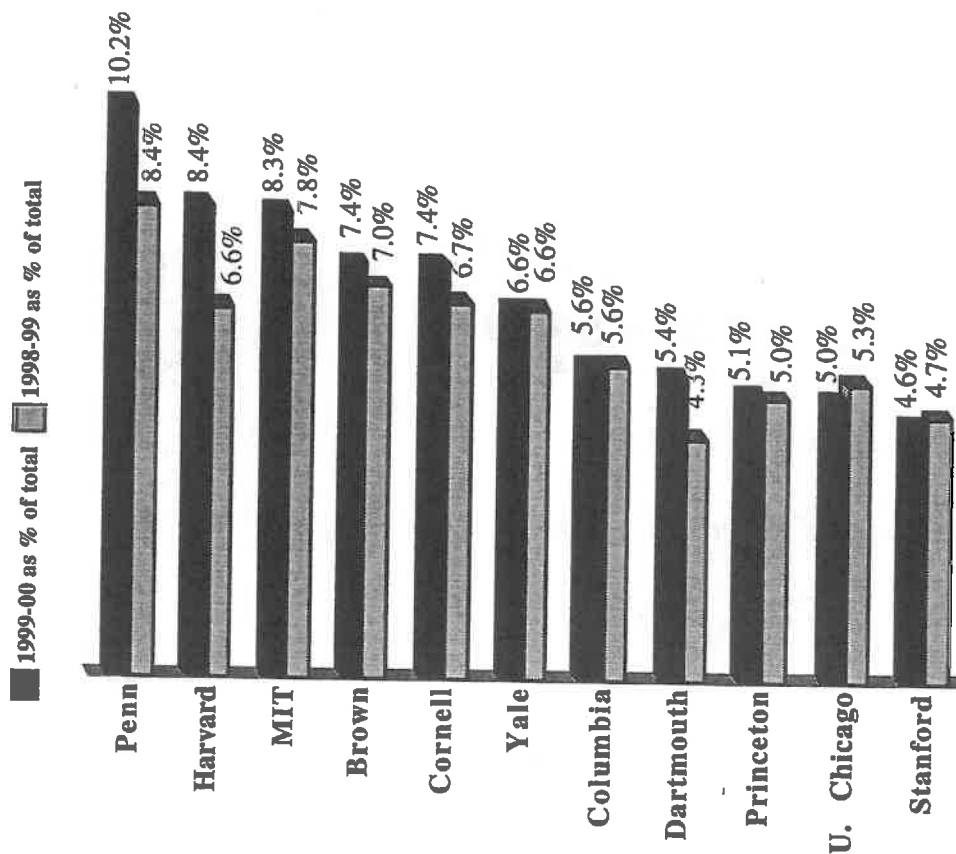

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AS A PERCENT OF ALL STUDENTS 1998-2000

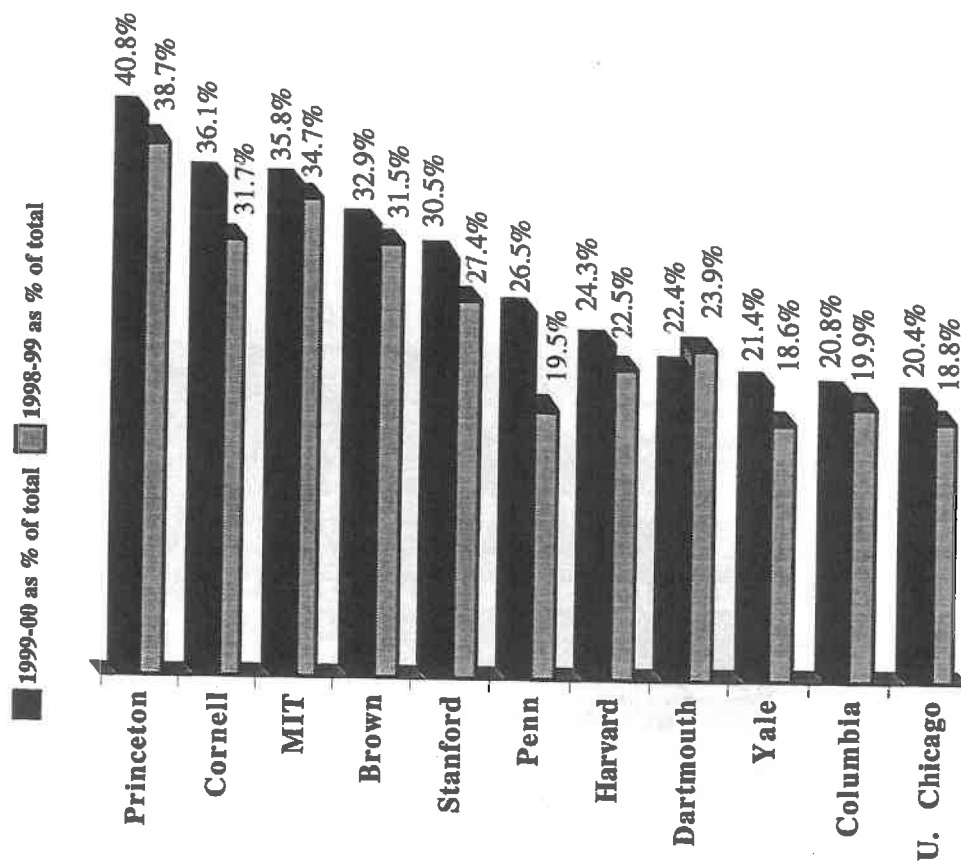

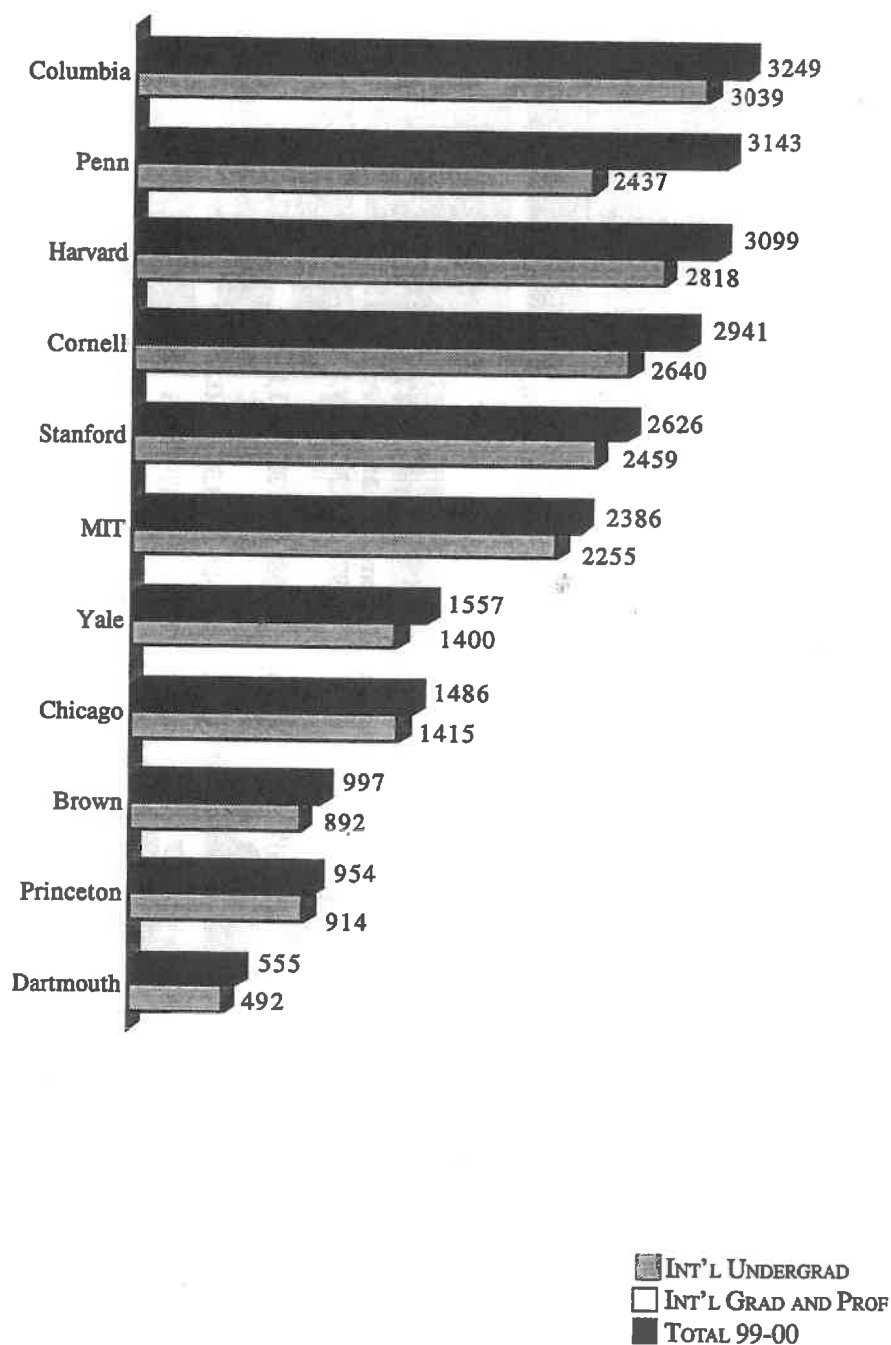

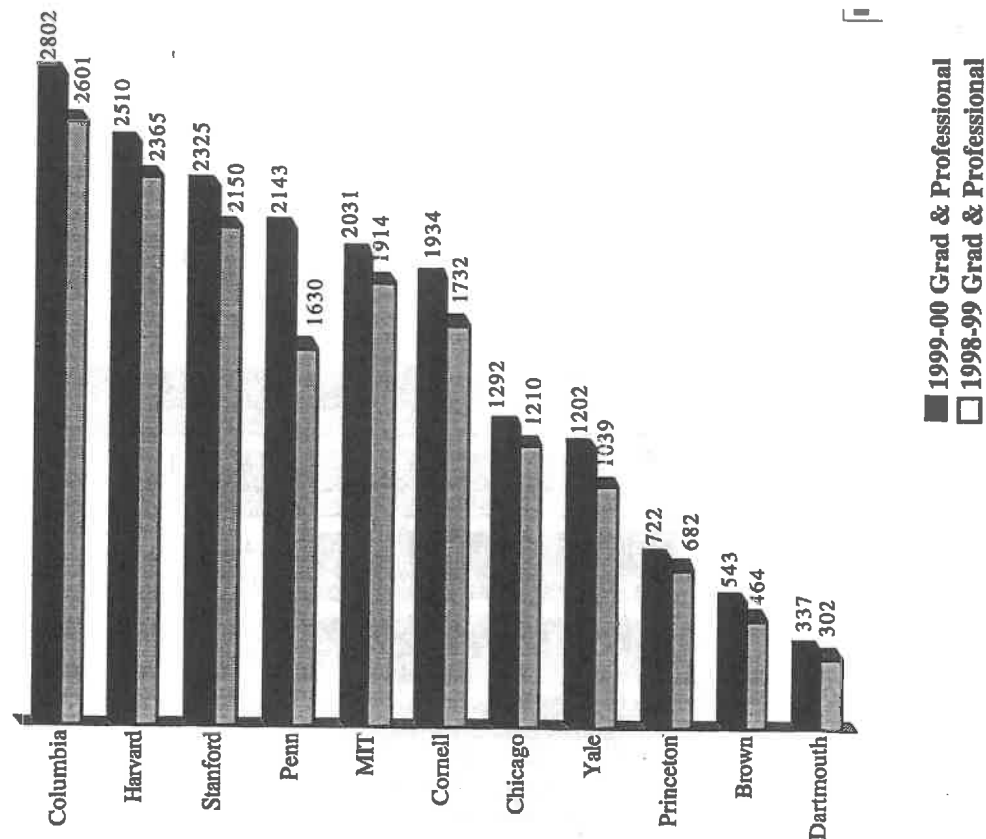
