- Primary literature is not enough

- Compared coverage of number of databases
- "This study indicates doing a search in CAB Abstracts for the agriculture journal literature will garner the most results. Doing an agriculture literature search in any or all of the other life sciences databases would be a duplication of effort."

- Need for rapid access to "valuable information from all corners of the world"
- "Small international journals are an endangered species in United States libraries"
- "What group will assume responsibility for maintaining active subscriptions to international journals and provide access at reasonable cost to researchers?"





CAB Abstracts coverage

- 499 of 542 core journals
 BUT
- Over 7,000 journals screened
- Over 1,300 journals cover to cover
- Material from several thousand publishers
- 3,000 publishers provide one title each



CABI study

- Accessions staff reviewed 542 core journals
 - Try to acquire the remaining 49
 - Heavily populated by major publisher titles
 - Heavy western bias
 - List needs continual adjustment
- Content editors reviewed international literature
 - Identified important, hard-to-find international journals
 - Determined availability of material
 - Recognised that not all publishers have the primary aim of serving shareholders



Building the International Full Text Concept

- Reviewed CABI expert content
- Contacted smaller publishers
- Questionnaire to customers
- Proof of concept
- Designed digital archive
- Contacted our hosts



Responses from End-Users

- Want access to difficult to find journals
- Want access to grey literature, particularly conferences
- Concern over net material disappearing
- Want access to CABI-generated expert literature
- Want it linked through CAB Abstracts
- Want it electronic



Responses from Publishers

- Reviews Archive
- Distribution Maps of Plant Diseases
- Distribution Maps of Plant Pests
- Descriptions of Fungi and Bacteria



CAB Abstracts Full Text Select

- A collection of authoritative, hard to find third-party content
- International scope
- 11,500 articles to date
- Building by 10,000 per year
- Journals, conferences, reports
- Metadata from CAB Abstracts
- PDF version of full article offered
- PDF created when none available



Full Text Select Journal Coverage

- Most start from 2005 volume
- Coverage aligned to CAB Abstracts: vets, animal science, agriculture, crop protection, horticulture, plant and animal breeding, soils
- Over 100 journals accepted and growing
- Truly international over 30 countries including: Italy, Switzerland, Spain, USA, Poland, India, Pakistan, Iran, Korea, China, Japan, Philippines, Brazil, Mexico, South Africa, Tanzania, Egypt...
